To qualify:

- Artists must reside in Oxford County and their studios must be within the county.
- New artists on the tour must be mentored (see below, and page 2)
- All work **must** be created by the artist listed eg. fibre arts, pottery/ceramics, wood, jewelry, paintings, etc. **No** retail sales of items from other sources are allowed.
- The listed artist must be in attendance for the entire tour.
- All new artist submissions will be juried by the committee and upon acceptance
 will receive notification regarding their acceptance. Artists previously
 participating on the tour will automatically be accepted depending on adherence
 to rules the previous year. Their application must be received by the deadline.

In order to be a participant in the Oxford Studio Tour 2026, you need to commit to participating either in person or virtually in any mandatory meetings.

The first meeting will be held after the artists have been selected for the Studio Tour. This will be to address all questions in regards to set ups, expectations, and promotional content. We will discuss strategies to bring in more online presence and how the artists can get more involved with marketing to help promote the Tour and span our reach of potential visitors and customers.

The second meeting will be held in March/April once the brochures/posters have been printed. This will be to organize our mailing lists and ensure that we have maximum coverage from all artists in distribution. We will also take this opportunity to discuss any final marketing pushes needed for the Studio Tour and any questions in regards to day of setups.

Please note, the Oxford Studio Tour is accepting, inclusive and supportive of all artists participating. There is zero tolerance for hate, discrimination, slander, or harassment of any kind from any artist on the tour.

Deadline for Submissions: December 6th, 2025

If you are a previous Oxford Studio Tour exhibitor please submit:

- 2 digital images (2Mb 5Mb in size) of artwork one horizontal and one vertical, if possible- to be used in the brochure. Images should contain only the artwork no frames should be visible for 2D items, backgrounds for 3D items should be minimal. Please name your digital files as follows: yoursurname1.jpg, yoursurname2.jpg for example smith1.jpg, smith2.jpg. Do not send photos labeled incorrectly as your application will be rejected. We have a large number of photos to organize and it saves a lot of time and prevents errors if these rules are adhered to. - 2. A brief description (15 words or less) of your work for the brochure. If you wish to use the same description from a previous year, please indicate.

- 4. A brief description of your work (15 words or less) for the brochure

 a guest artist in a studio of one of the artists from the previous year(s). Please
 indicate at which studio you would be located. It is up to applicants to arrange
 their studio location **prior to applying for the tour.**
